### **Deacon Nominations**

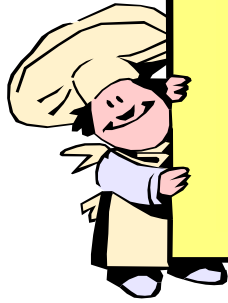
