## **Worship Matters**

Our Book of Church Order says “A service of public worship is not merely a gathering of God’s children with each other, but before all else, a meeting of the triune God with His chosen people. God is present in public worship not only by virtue of the Divine omnipresence but, much more intimately, as the faithful covenant Savior. It behooves God’s people not only to come into His presence with a deep sense of awe at the thought of His perfect holiness and their own exceeding sinfulness, but also to enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise for the great salvation, which He has so graciously wrought for them through his only begotten Son and applied to them by the Holy Spirit.”

In light of this exhortation some advice: Come each Sunday prepared to Worship. Talk with your family - especially young children about what you are doing during a service. Think of others. Don’t create or be a distraction. Minimize young children leaving and coming into worship times.

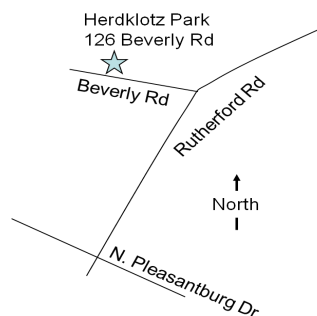
