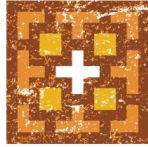

## **VBS Mission Project**

June Gallman, our missionary in Costa Rica, works with women in prison teaching them academics and life skills as well as spiritual lessons. When the women are released, the transition back to life outside of prison is difficult for them and their children. The Lord has enabled June to purchase a home which she intends to use to help with this transition. Its size is sufficient to house several of these women with their children from the time of their release from prison until they can obtain suitable housing.

June has purchased cots, and she needs bed linens and pillows to prepare for her house guests. In our VBS Bible Boot Camp this week, we want to see how many pillows and sets of sheets we can buy for her to use in this part of her missions. What a great way for us to be involved in this ministry of helping women who have been equipped with new life in Christ as well as skills for a new way to provide for themselves and their families.

YOU can be a part of this as well. Simply designate your donation to the church for VBS Mission Project. You may want to match the funds the children bring or just feel free to give as much as you want. All of it will go toward this important missionary endeavor.
