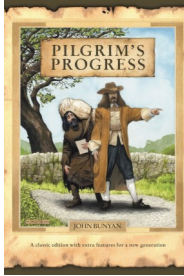

When the women are released, the transition back to life outside of prison is difficult for them and their children. The Lord has enabled June to purchase a home which she intends to use to help with this transition. Its size is sufficient to house several of these women with their children from the time of their release from prison until they can obtain suitable housing.


June has purchased cots, and she needs bed linens and pillows to prepare for her house guests.
