New Members' Luncheon

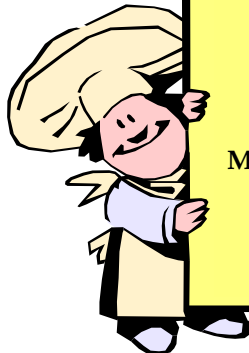
All members and visitors are cordially invited to a luncheon honoring our new members,
