Live Webcast Trouble

Many of you have experienced issues watching SPC services online over the past many weeks. There were issues with the SPC network as well as SermonAudio's servers being overloaded with the growing demand on their infrastructure. We have installed a second, dedicated internet circuit for the live webcast and SermonAudio has just increased their capacity by 30% to accommodate the increased load. The live webcast should be much more stable going forward. The live webcast service is an increasing part of SPC's ministry, reaching hundreds of folks each month who are unable to attend services.
