- Budgeted Contributions are \$25,805 less than the budgeted amount of \$590,833 for the five months ended May 31, 2019.
- Actual contributions to the budget YTD 2018 were \$502,137. Year over year-to-date collections have increased by \$62,892. This is due to a few onetime offerings approximating \$86,000.
- Mission support payments approximating \$45,000 were distributed on May 28th.
