## The Confession of Sin and Supplication for Grace

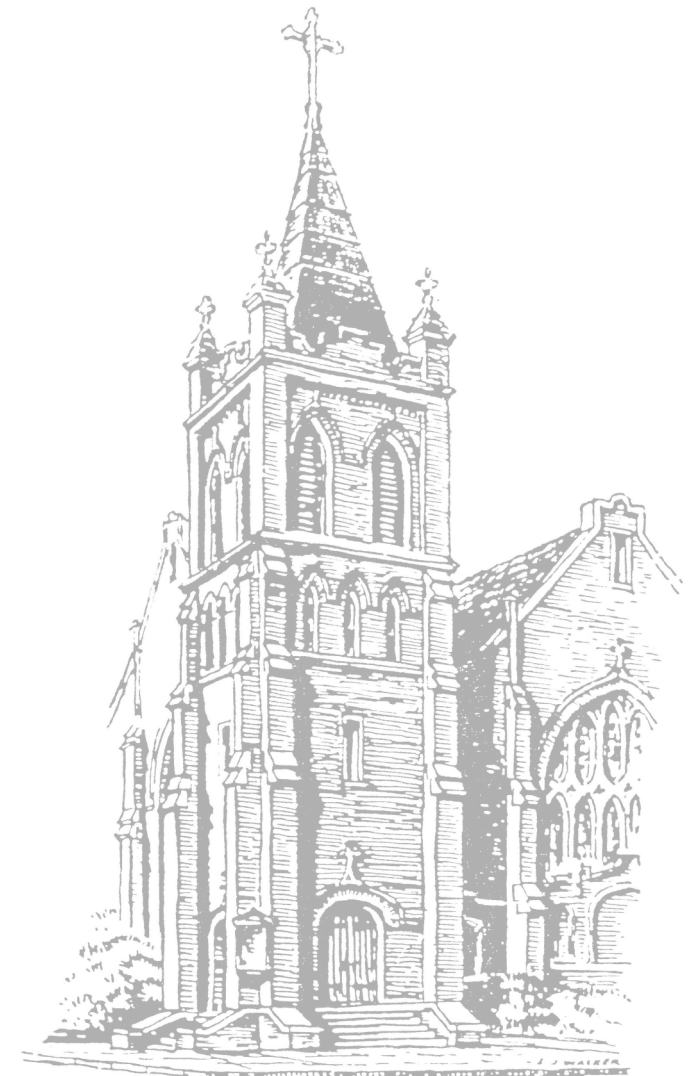
