"I declare that these women have been duly elected and installed as officers of the Women In the Church of Second Presbyterian Church."

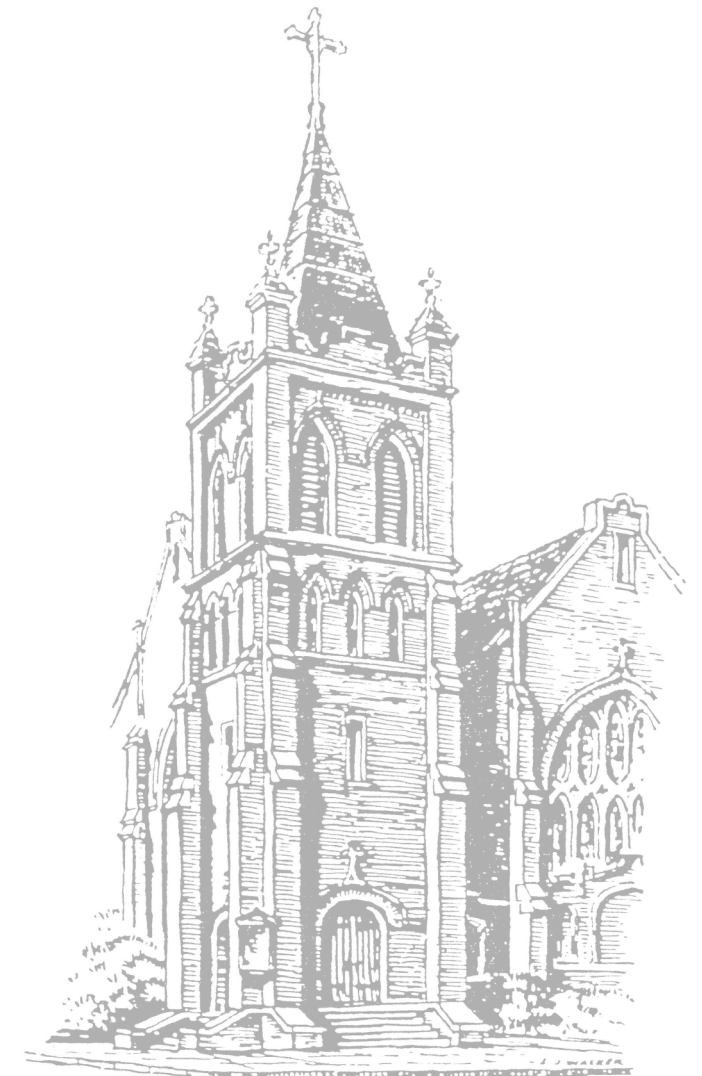
