- B. B. Will you support these officers with your cooperation, encouraging words and prayers?

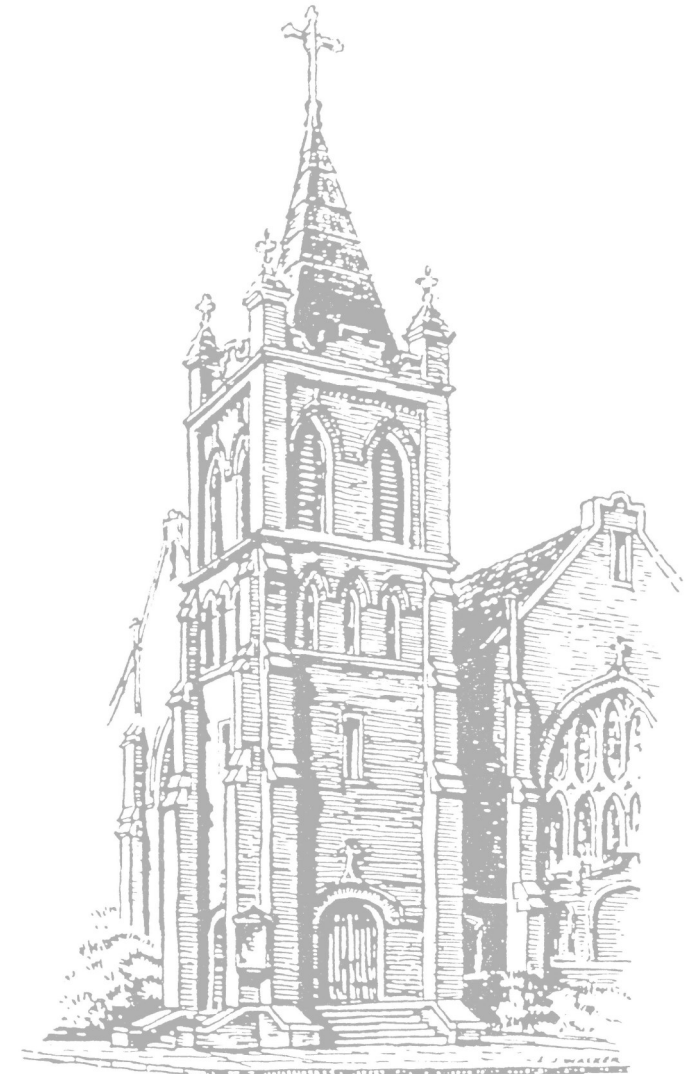
