Second Presbyterian Church wants to show you Christian Hospitality and minister to you through the Word of God.

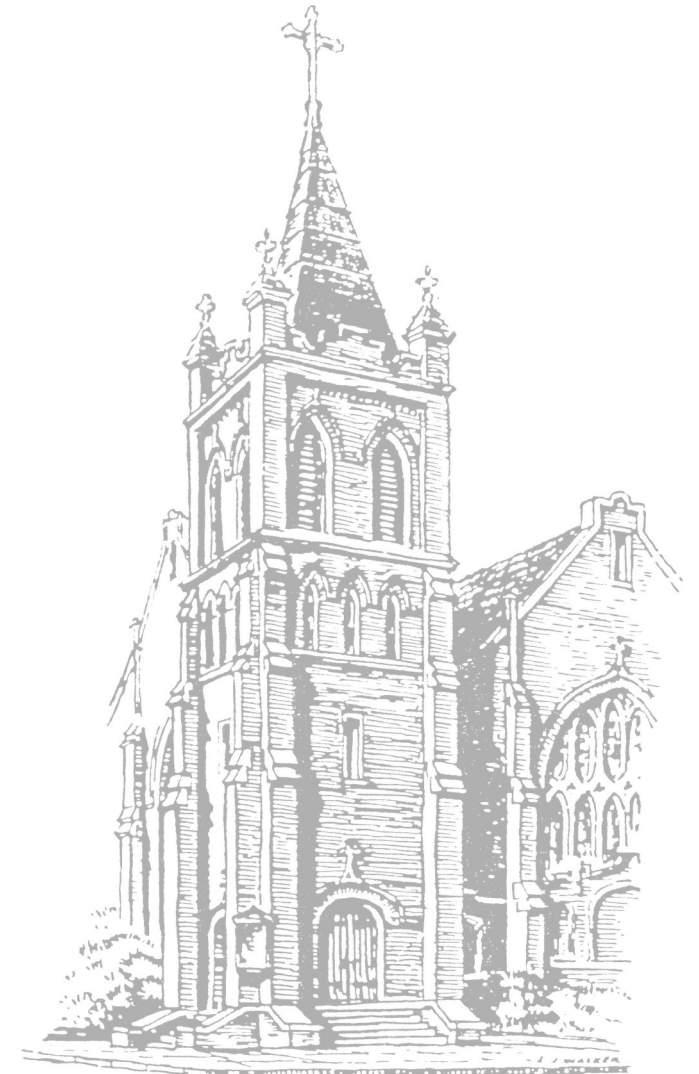
