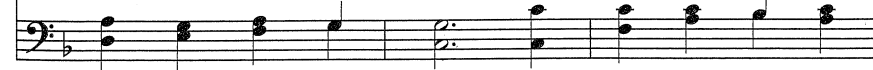

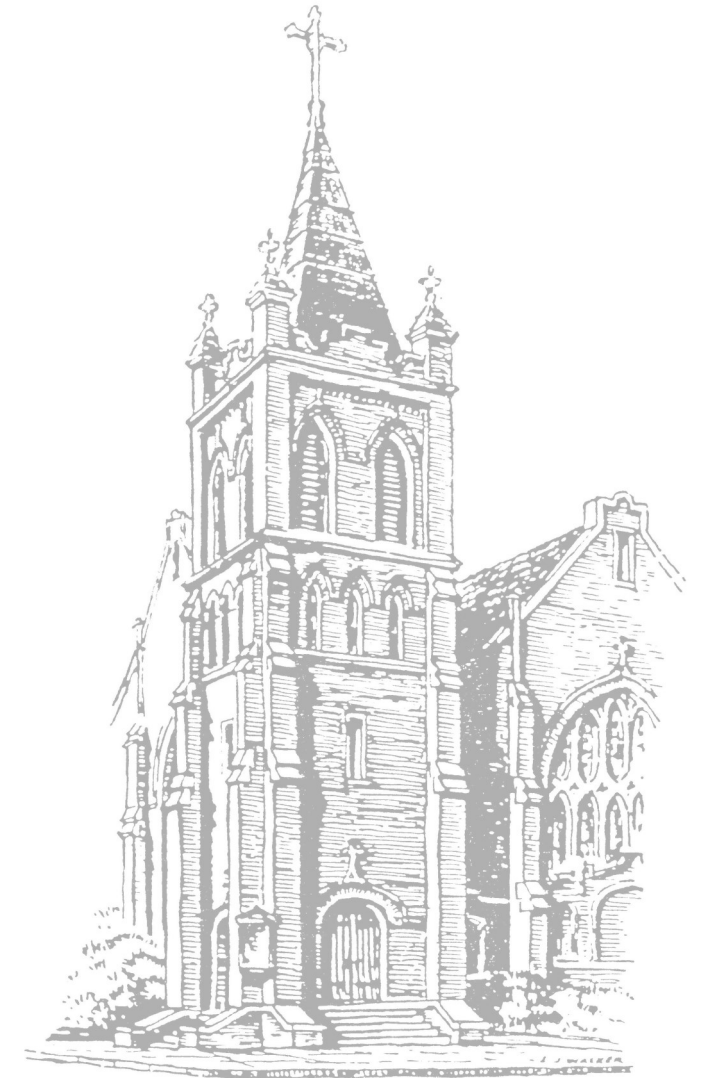
### Preparation for The Lord's Supper
