 But be not far from me, O LORD; hur-ry, my Strength, send

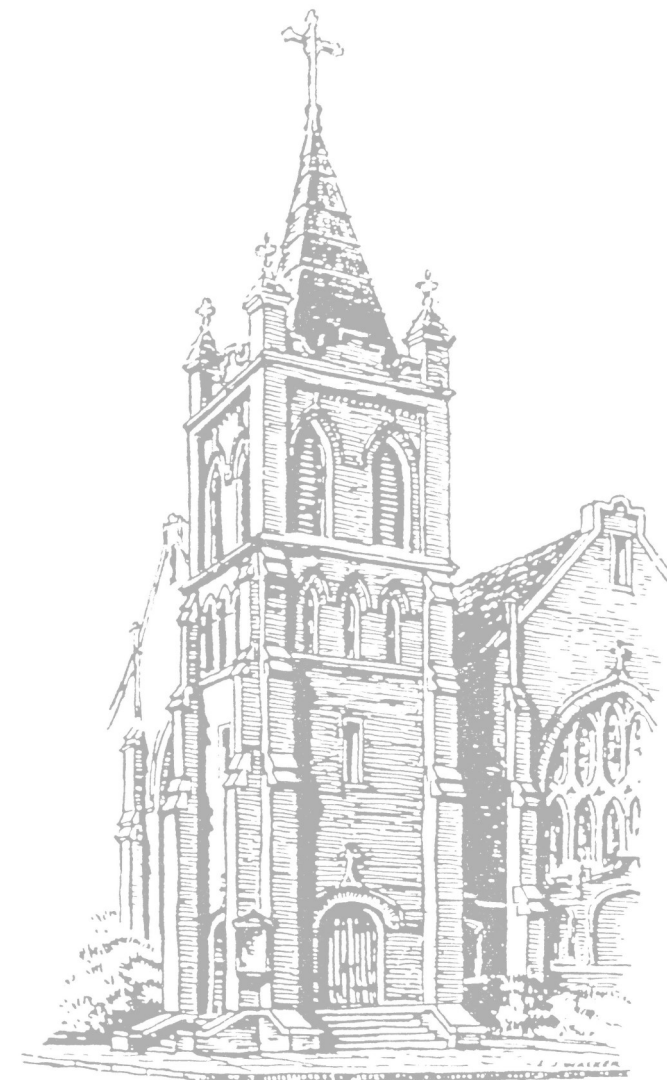
face my foes. Like man-y bulls they cir-cle me; strong
