 My foot now stands on lev - el ground, A place of up - right - ness;

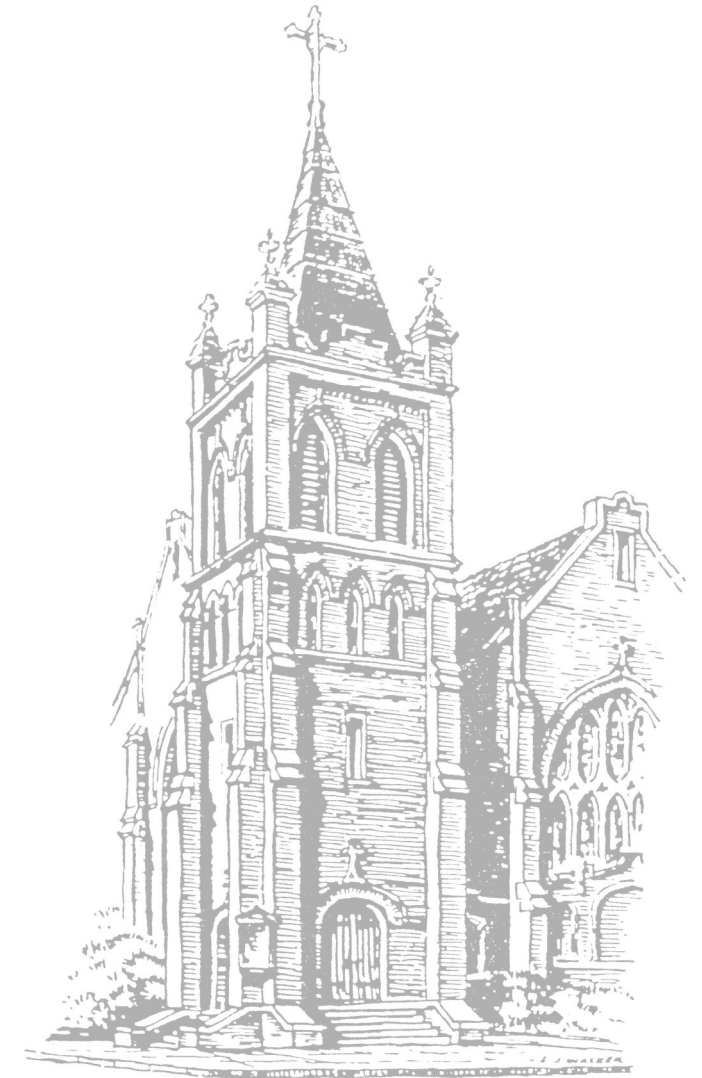
Since I be - hold Your stead - fast love; Your truth has led my way.
