Psalm 31:9-18



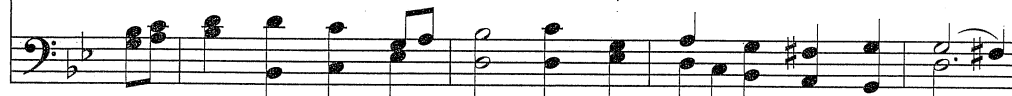
O LORD, be gra-cious to me, Be - cause of my tra - vail;

That speak a - gainst the righ - teous, With words of proud dis - dain.

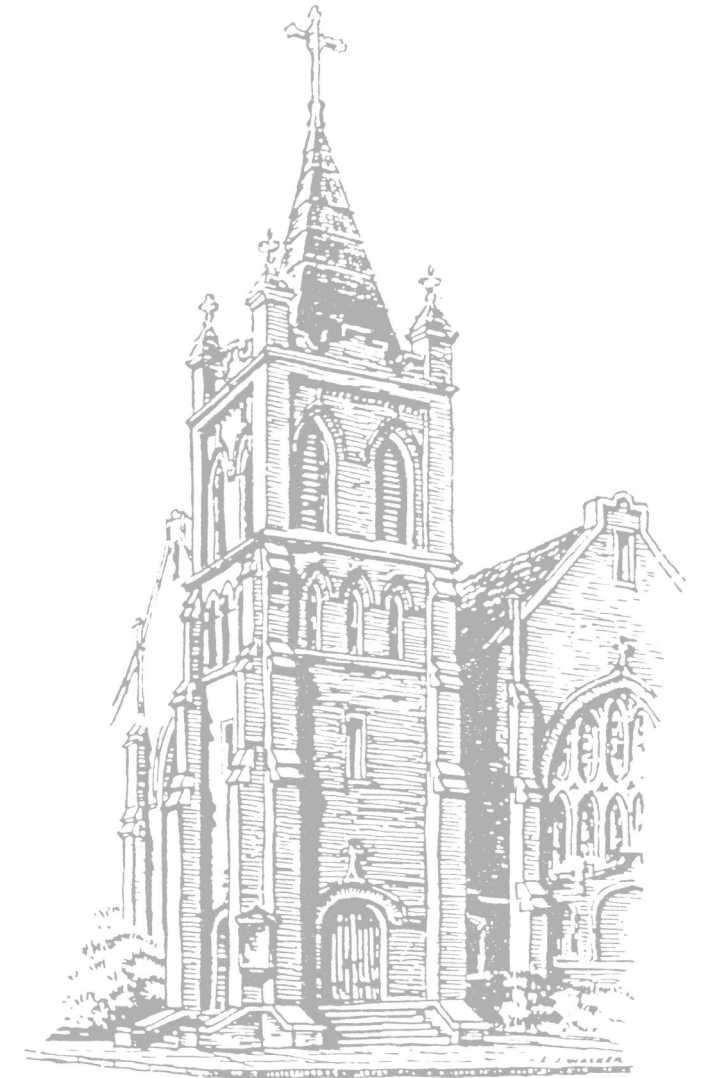
