5. Do you submit yourself to the government and discipline of the Church, and promise to strive for its purity and peace?

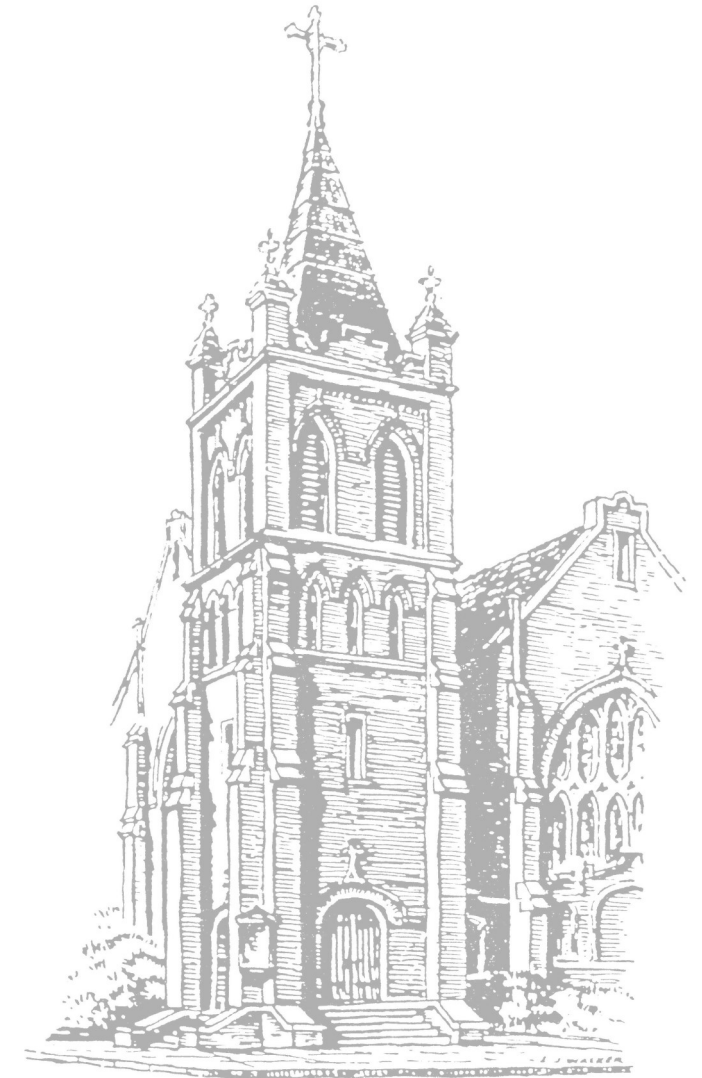
