I will dwell in the house of the Lord all my days.

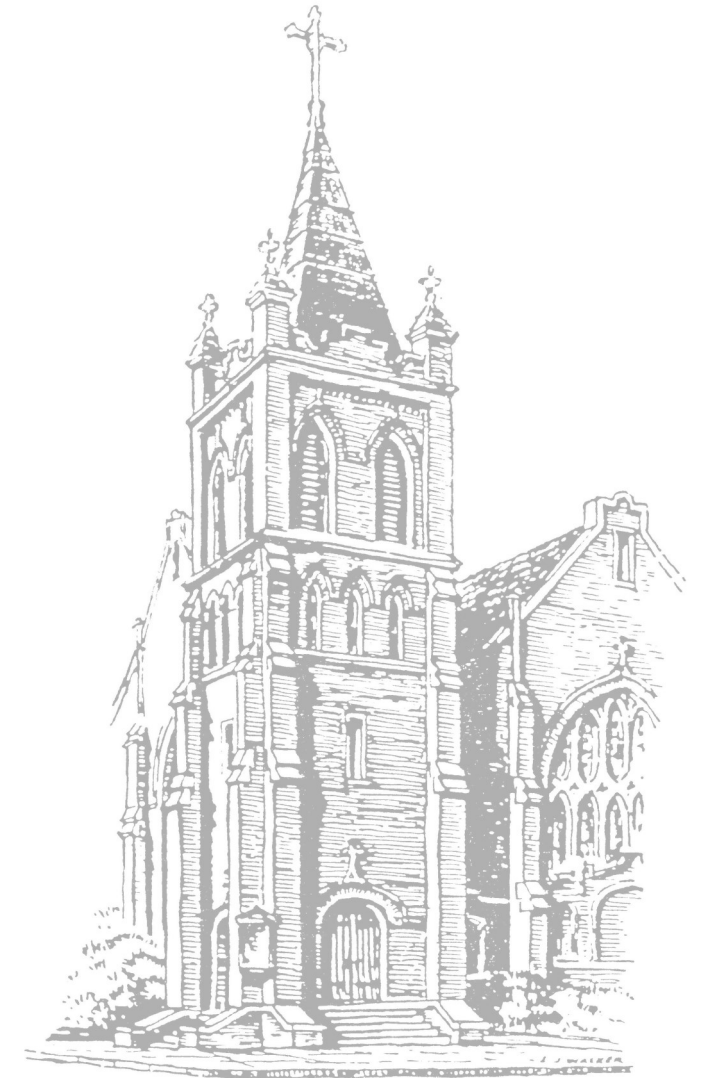
