ac - cus - ing those who live at peace and qui - et in the land.

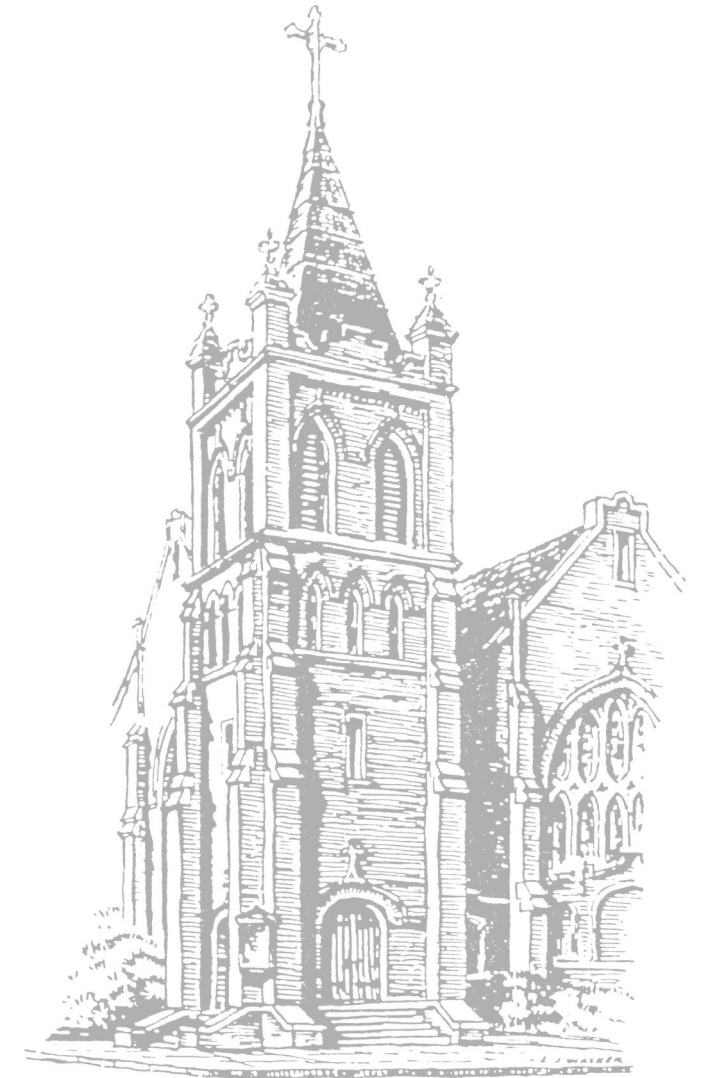
