- 1) Our giving should be regular and intentional. The biblical idea is not simply putting some money in the plate as the mood strikes us or as it seems good to us to give. Instead, we should think through our giving, plan for our giving, and give regularly as a matter of habit. Paul thus wrote to the Corinthians, "On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper" (1 Cor. 16:2). Our data shows that our financial needs as a church can be met if we all give in a regular and intentional way.
- 2) Our giving should be proportional. That same teaching shows that we should give according to the way God has prospered us. The best starting place for our giving should be the tithe, which is the giving of 10% of our gross income back to the work of the Lord (see Lev. 27:30; Dt. 14:22). Some of our families have experienced significant financial downturns during the last year, and this will inevitable cause them to decrease their giving to the church. We should all do our best, however, to give faithfully to the Lord in a proportional way, in keeping with the Bible's teaching.
- 3) Our giving should be cheerful and thankful. Giving to the work of the Lord should never be thought of as a legalistic burden but rather as a privilege and joy. Paul wrote: "Each one must give as he has made up his mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor. 9:7). While we should never give with a thought of what God will do to reward us, the Bible does frankly state that God cares about our generosity in giving to support His work and responds in terms of His provision for us (see 2 Cor. 9:6-11 and Mal. 3:10).
- 4) Our giving is something that we do together in order to accomplish God's work together. One of the vows every member takes in joining our church is to "support the worship and work of the church to the best of my ability." This embraces our whole involvement in the church, but it also speaks to our financial support. Every member should seek to give as much as possible to the work of the gospel, both in and outside of our church. Jesus tells us that "where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Lk. 12:34), so that our treasuring the gospel of salvation will be seen in our giving to support and spread Christ's work.

I usually do not experience a great deal of anxiety over church finances, since I know that God will wonderfully provide for His gospel. But I know that it is important to each of us to be faithful in this matter and that the Lord cares about what we treasure. Let's each of us do our part individually and let us together seek to provide for the financial needs of Second Church this year. If we do that, I am sure that God will be honored and we will have what we need to minister to our congregation and reach out to the world. Let me express my thanks to the generous and faithful members of this church who honor God with their giving, through which God enables us to spread His saving grace both near and far, to the praise of His name.

Letter from the Senior Minister.... Giving

Included in our newsletter this week is information on our giving towards the 2010 church budget. We have many reasons to give thanks to God as our giving has increased in recent years, allowing us to support and expand the ministry of Second Church in significant ways. A couple of years ago, increased giving enabled us to call Pastor Fluhrer to serve full time as assistant pastor to youth and families. I think we are all agreed as to what an important contribution Gabe has made to the spiritual growth of our young men and women. We will all be sad to see Gabe and Callie depart as they invest in their long-term usefulness to Christ by beginning the PhD program at Westminster Seminary, but we are grateful to God in providing the Starkeys to take up the mantel in service to our youth.

This summer we are making an addition that I think will be equally significant, the hiring of Melton L. Duncan to serve as church administrator. At present our growing church of over 500 members, with expanding attendance and ministries, has no full-time administrative employees. We praise the Lord for the long and outstanding service of Judy Grant, who as our office administrator is fully engaged in producing our bulletins and newsletters and in serving the daily administrative needs of our staff. It has become increasingly apparent, however, that Second greatly needs a church administrator to tie together all the ministry and facility functions of our church, to coordinate the action items of our church committees, and to foster excellence in our overall outreach and pastoral care.

As our church staff experiences modest expansion in response to our church growth, we are being well served by those church officers who oversee our finances. Through their wise planning, the staff transitions mentioned above are projected to take place within our existing 2010 church budget. It will be important, however, for us to achieve our budget goals for this year as we will begin financially planning for 2011. In short, as church growth requires expanding ministry, we need increased giving so as to keep pace. Our church treasurer, David Rainey, will give a financial report before the worship services this week so as to keep you informed as to our finances. The key item in his report is that at the half-way mark for the year we are \$52,000 behind and we need to make this up over the remaining months of the year.

Please keep our financial needs in prayer, asking that the Lord would provide for us as we desire to serve Him more greatly. Let me offer, as well, four points of biblical counsel about our individual and family giving as church members:
