

this to be a way for us to get to know you and interact with you personally as you join the church. If you have a special reason why you cannot attend the new members' class, please let us know and we would be happy to make needed arrangements.

If you have been attending our church and think you might like to make it your church home, let me encourage you to enter into formal membership. Let me give you three good reasons for church membership:

- ◆ First, God intends each of us to be a source of blessing to others. Everything God has given you – time, talents, spiritual gifts, money, experience – is in part intended to be means for you to bless God's work in and through the church (see Romans 12:4-5; Hebrews 3:13).
- ◆ Secondly, Jesus' body is the church – not just individual Christians, but Christians organized together as the church (Eph. 1:23). Jesus loves the church and cares for the church. Since God has entered into saving covenant with us, he calls for us to enter into covenant relationships with other believers. The best expression of this is joining a sound, Bible-teaching church. The church is Christ's agency and army in this world, and Christians are to be joined to it in covenant bonds.
- ◆ Thirdly, Jesus has established pastors and elders to shepherd the flock and care for the church. Being a member of the church places you into the fold and under this care (Heb. 13:7, 17). Church membership brings important privileges such as the prayers and pastoral care of the church. Jesus uses members working together under godly, biblical leadership to build up His Church and lead His people to spiritual maturity (Eph. 4:11-13).

Second Presbyterian Church is committed to doing God's work in God's way, as a caring community of brothers and sisters in Christ. If this is your regular place of worship and if God is blessing you here, perhaps the Lord would have you inquire about becoming a member. God wants you to be blessed in the church, and he wants you in the church to be a blessing to others. 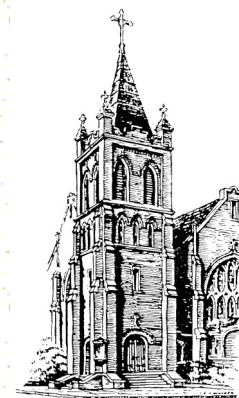

## Letter From The Senior Minister New Members' Class

Beginning Sunday morning, September 12, our church will begin a new members' class. The class will meet over seven consecutive weeks during the Sunday School period, from 9:50-10:45 in the Fellowship Hall. If you have been visiting our church and think that you might like to become a member, this would be ideal for you.

We receive members on the basis of a credible profession of faith in Jesus Christ and a willingness to enter into the solemn covenant with God's people that membership entails. Members pledge to support the church in its worship, support the church in its work, to submit to the government and discipline of the church, and to pursue its purity and peace. Even though members are not required to hold to all the tenets of the Reformed faith and Presbyterian church government, it is important for all of us to understand the teaching of our church and the biblical basis for it. With this in mind our class will include the following sessions:

- Sept. 12, 2010 The Solas of the Protestant Reformation (Pastor Phillips)
- Sept. 19, 2010 The Doctrines of Grace (Pastor Phillips)
- Sept. 26, 2010 Law and Gospel (Pastor Phillips)
- Oct. 3, 2010 Duties and privileges of church membership (Pastor Spears)
- Oct. 10, 2010 Reformed Worship (Pastor Phillips)
- Oct. 17, 2010 Covenant Theology and Sacraments (Pastor Phillips)
- Oct. 24, 2010 Presbyterian Church History (Dr. Waugh).
- Nov. 7, 2010 New Members Reception

If you are interested in doing some advanced reading, I would recommend *On Being Presbyterian*, written by Dr. Sean Lucas. Also, powerpoint slides for my classes are available on our church website ([www.secondpca.org](http://www.secondpca.org)). Some of you may have attended the joint Sunday School this summer in the sanctuary and have heard this material there. I would ask you to attend the new members' class, since we want
