

The goal of the new relationship with this company is primarily to regain control of our own parking lot and allow our own people, ministry, special neighbors and partnering ministry groups to be uninterrupted and unaffected by the new parking regulations. The Diaconate's Building and Property Committee is working to prevent any inconvenience to our own congregation as we implement this new system.

Here are a few questions you may have:

Can I park at Second Presbyterian Church during weekday business hours?

Yes, the church is working with Lanier to number our parking spaces. Any unnumbered space (approximately 70) will be available exclusively to Second Church people at all times. A survey conducted by the Building and Property Committee has shown this will allow us to have more than adequate parking for our own use or the use of our ministry partners. If this number needs to change we can adjust this with Lanier.

Can I park at Second Presbyterian Church during evening hours/weekends?

Yes, again. 70 spaces will be reserved for our own use at all times.

How will Lanier know that I am from Second Presbyterian Church?

The church has designed a new car id logo see below (available as an adhesive sticker or a placard to hang from your mirror) that can be used to identify your parking privileges at Second Church. These car id's will be available to pick up after registering by the church library on February 5th.

Are we enforcing parking on Sunday or Wednesday Nights?

No enforcement will occur on the Lord's Day, or during stated church activities on Wednesday Nights.

Additionally the church has made a special stipulation for our own Boy Scout troop #828, to continue their own management of the parking lot during the annual "Artisphere" and "Fall for Greenville" festivals. We will work with our church ministry partners to provide them suitable "car id" for use of our parking facility.

What happens if I get a "notice"?

Contact the Administrator in the church office (864.232.7621 extension 14). The church will not allow church members to be financially penalized. The church will actively look after our own members' parking needs.

Is the church benefiting commercially from Lanier?

Yes, the church will receive a modest monthly rental payment (a few hundred dollars) from Lanier Parking Systems but the primary benefit is one of regaining control of the parking lot. The church officers have determined that the new multi-story Hughes building due to be completed this spring, will effectively flood all available parking unless we implement this new parking plan.

What if I work downtown and need a place to park?

The simple answer to this question is to talk with the Administrator. The Diaconate will be developing some "new policy" related to parking as we begin the relationship with Lanier. We value your feedback and input.

Let me add a special word of thanks to the Diaconate for working on this issue. We are blessed to have active Deacons who care for our facility and property.

Please make us aware of problems or concerns. A reminder that car id tags will be available by the church library beginning February 5th to any member of the congregation that registers. As long as you register you are welcome to take more than one car id/sticker.

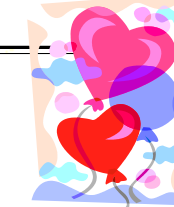
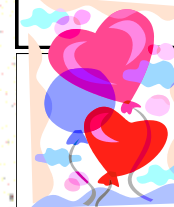

Letter from the Church Administrator Parking at The Second Presbyterian Church

The city of Greenville is a very busy place. Our church is benefiting from business and development changes that have happened in our neighborhood over the last few years. The skyscrapers of Main Street lead to the Peace Center, Riverplace and into our own beloved West End. The seven story Hughes Building is soon to open across River Street and will bring a whole new group of neighbors-walking, bicycling and living – a community right around our church, right in the heart of the city. The church officers have been proactive in monitoring city planning, code issues, and development for our neighborhood. Our location in the city creates some unique challenges to our overall ministry and one of those key challenges is *parking*.

For many years Second Church has had an understanding with a handful of neighboring businesses and residents about parking- a simple arrangement; we have available parking that they can use if they need, and these businesses often provided unsolicited gifts-in-kind to the church. Many of these relationships go back a generation. The old Shealy Company on Rhett Street provided us light bulbs and City Welding Company allowed the use of their specialized machinery. In recent years we have benefited from tenants on Main Street and over at Riverplace. There also have been hundreds (maybe thousands) of occasions where the church has given businesses and individuals free parking for no benefit to us, because it was *neighborly* to do so. Among these were bus parking for school programs at the Peace Center, noon time restaurant patrons, folks visiting the shops along South Main and even tourists making day trips to Falls Park. A good number of people parking in our lot of late have been employees of large businesses in Greenville that do not provide free parking. There are times in the last two years in particular where we have struggled to regain control of our parking for funerals, special services, meetings, conferences because so many different businesses were (frankly) taking advantage of us. A word needs to be said here about the heroic efforts of our own Judy Grant, Administrative Assistant *par excellence* who has ably communicated and in some cases enforced the church use of its own property over the last decade.

All of this is happening at a time when our church has never been busier during business hours. The ever growing ministry of our own congregation combined with ministry partners that use our campus and facility (like the Boy Scouts, BACH Choir, Creation Study Group, Church League Basketball, CC Greenville *et al*) keep our building and our parking lots busy and often times *full*. With increased demand comes a new challenge for our parking.

In response, the Diaconate of Second Church in consultation with the Session, has studied the matter carefully and decided that the use of a parking management service was needed. Lanier Parking System was the company chosen; it is a full service, insured parking management company with a good reputation that works with many churches in downtown Greenville. Beginning February 6th our church parking lot will be "managed" by this company. In the next few weeks you will notice some new signage going up around the church to this effect.
