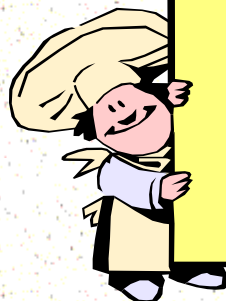

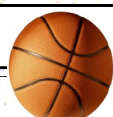
Calling All Ice Cream Makers

All deacon nominees must meet the requirements of Holy Scripture, the PCA Book of Church Order, and Second Presbyterian Church (SPC). Deacons must be men who are:

- believers who hold the deep truths of the faith with clear conscience (1 Tim. 3: 9)
- of spiritual character (BCO 9-3)
- worthy of respect (1 Tim. 3:8)
- temperate in consumption (1 Tim 3:8)
- sincere (1 Tim. 3:8)
- honest (1 Tim. 3:8, BCO 9-3)
- of spiritual character (BCO 9-3)
- exemplary in life (BCO 9-3)
- brotherly in spirit (BCO 9-3)
- warm towards other members (BCO 9-3)
- of sound judgment (BCO 9-3)
- member of Second Presbyterian Church for at least 2 years at the time of election (SPC)

Each member should carefully and prayerfully evaluate all potential nominees against the above list of requirements.

A committee of Deacons will collect the submitted nomination forms. A list will then be compiled of all those submitted who are on the eligibility list which will be posted outside the church office. This list is compiled by the Session from male communing members who at least minimally are not in open violation of any of the requirements for a deacon.

The Deacons Committee will then submit the list to the Session, which will have final authority to accept the slate and alternates list as presented or to alter it before it is adopted. Nominees will then be contacted to secure their consent to be a candidate and to participate in the required training program and examination by the Session.

All candidates will be required to attend the training. After the training, the candidates will be examined by the Session.

The final slate of candidates will be published in a bulletin insert with biographical sketches the week that the congregational meeting for deacon elections is announced. The election will be held by private ballot at a 10 am congregational meeting on the announced Sunday. Each member may vote for **six (6)** or fewer men (at this time) from the candidates.

The top vote-getters will be elected (provided they receive a majority of the eligible voters present).

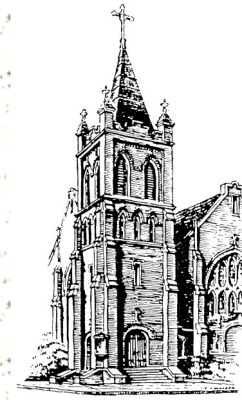

Letter from the Session

Deacon nomination and Election Procedure

The Session calls all communing members of Second Presbyterian Church in good standing to give prayerful consideration in preparation for participation in the important responsibility given to the church of electing godly men to the office of deacon. There are possibly 6 vacancies to be filled at this time for the class of 2017 and more vacancies may occur in other classes.

The nomination and election schedule will be as follows:

Nomination Period	Sept. 1-15
Compilation of Nominees	Sept. 16
Session Meeting to approve slate	Sept. 18
Contact Nominees for Training	Sept. 19-20
Deacon Nominee Training	Sept. 22 – Nov. 3
Session examination of nominees	Nov. 11; 8:00 pm or Nov. 13, 8:00 pm
Congregational Meeting for election	Sunday, Dec. 1; 10 am
Ordination/Installation of Deacons	Sunday, Dec. 1; 6 pm

Nomination forms may be placed in the offering plate or submitted to the Church office anytime during the intervening weeks. Each member will be asked to sign the nomination form. **Unsigned** forms will not be considered. (There will be no requirement for voter identification during the actual election.)
