Missionary Report

Ray and Michelle Call: Uruguay

1. Pray for our health and that of our missionary teammates.
2. Pray for a place for our church plant to begin meeting. We are looking either for a place to rent on Sundays or a building to rent full time. Our target area is called La Blanqueada. We are mainly looking for a meeting place in this neighborhood.
3. Pray for our worship services. We begin this Sunday with just the two missionary families (but everything will be in Spanish). We will meet in one of our homes until we can find a place.
4. Pray for evangelism. We are making friends with folks in the community and have been able to share who we are and what we are doing. Ask the Lord to open doors to share more deeply the things of God.
5. Pray for physical and spiritual protection.
6. Thank the Lord for knitting the two missionary families together. Ask for continued fellowship, unity and growth in our relationships – especially for our children.
7. Give glory to the Lord for helping us to make progress with the new website, narrowing down which neighborhood we will focus on, open doors to share Christ as well as a host of things the Lord has brought about to make our lives more settled here in a foreign place.
8. Ask the Lord to lead us to mature Christians who would be interested in joining new Reformed church plant.
9. Pray for a new Presbyterian denomination – There are 3 other Presbyterian churches (we will be the fourth) in the nation of Uruguay. One is in Rivera to the North, one is in Mercedes to the Northwest and one is here in Montevideo (besides us). We met with representatives from each of these a couple months ago and had an encouraging meeting. Ask the Lord to open doors for us all to pull together and form into a presbytery someday in the Lord's timing.

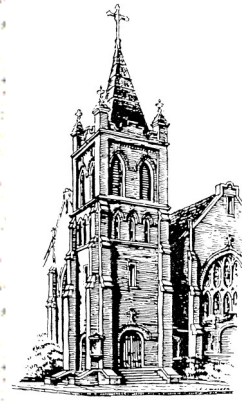

Letter from Mr. Jeffrey Windt Ministerial Intern at Second

Earlier this spring Rev. Roland Barnes of Trinity PCA in Statesboro, Georgia contacted me regarding my interest in a full time ministry position at Trinity. Dr. Phillips, Seth Starkey and others had recommended me to him for the position. This came as a surprise to me as I have not actively looked for a position and was unaware that I had been referred (also given the fact that I was still a year away from graduation.) Rev. Barnes asked me to send him a statement of my views and my philosophy of youth ministry, and after several weeks asked me to come down to interview with the session.

I have accepted the position at Trinity PCA of Director of Youth Ministries beginning September 1, 2015. Lord willing I will graduate in May 2016 from RTS Charlotte and will seek ordination in Savannah River Presbytery at that time. Lord willing I will then pursue a call as Associate Minister at Trinity in July 2016. The Lord has provided an ideal rental house at an affordable price for our first several months in Statesboro.

As of the end of August I will have had the great privilege of serving as ministerial intern at SPC for one year. I want to express my immense gratitude to the session of SPC for this tremendous opportunity to serve this church. I am so thankful for the opportunity to minister to the covenant young people of this church!
