Read Today's Scripture

I KINGS 18:22-40

Then Elijah said to the people, "I, even I only, am left a prophet of the Lord, but Baal's prophets are 450 men. Let two bulls be given to us, and let them choose one bull for themselves and cut it in pieces and lay it on the wood, but put no fire to it. And I will prepare the other bull and lay it on the wood and put no fire to it. And you call upon the name of your god, and I will call upon the name of the Lord, and the God who answers by fire, he is God." And all the people answered, "It is well spoken." Then Elijah said to the prophets of Baal, "Choose for yourselves one bull and prepare it first, for you are many, and call upon the name of your god, but put no fire to it." Jay and his wife Sumter, who work with the Samburu of Kenya held their first ever Vacation Bible School at their church the week before Christmas. 20 volunteers signed up to help the Sunday School teachers lead the VBS for the children. The theme was Investigating the Hidden Hero—searching for the hidden hero in God's Word. Their hope is to see the Samburu people come to a full understanding of the Gospel and witness the creation of self-propagating Samburu-led churches. The Samburu are an isolated tribe with very little access to the Gospel. The Brantleys have been living in Kenya serving the Samburu since 2018.
