## DANIEL 2:1-23

In the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; his spirit was troubled, and his sleep left him. Then the king commanded that the magicians, the enchanters, the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans be summoned to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king. ## COSTA RICA MISSION TRIP



From January 9-14, Sharon Phillips, Christian Trautner, Gerilyn McGaughran and Eugenia McKee visited our missionary partner, June Gallman, in San Jose, Costa Rica. While in Costa Rica, they participated in two eyeglass clinics where they were able to distribute countless Spanish tracts and around 120 pair of eyeglasses to those in need. They spent time visiting with June in her home, exploring her local community and worshipping with her at her church. The experience emphasized the need for missions work in Costa Rica due to the stronghold the Catholic church has over the people and institutions within the country and for the unreached, rural communities outside San Jose.
