It's there among such beauty in God's creation that we will find our retreat setting, the Unicoi State Park & Lodge. From old hymns by bonfire light to the exploration of biblical hospitality through scripture, fun break-out sessions to meaningful fellowship, and tranquil views of mountains to waterfall sightseeing, the time is sure to be well spent.



Accommodations...

The lodge is nestled inside the beautiful state park and just a knoll's walk away from the conference center and restaurant. Rooms will be on two levels of which ground level rooms may be requested. With traditional hotel style accommodations, you're sure to have a comfortable stay. Each room will have two double or queen sized beds along with the following amenities:
